Our understanding of the information requested is as follows:

- Specific details of the criteria used to decide that your level of experience was not sufficient.
- Any and all relevant information as to the required level of experience necessary for each of the essential criteria.
- The specific criteria used to decided the required level of experience under each of the essential criteria.

In answer to your request for information, I can confirm that the following information is being released.

Question 1

The specific areas of the essential criteria under which your application form did not demonstrate sufficient experience were:

- experience of research and analysis of complex information and compilation of formal, structured reports to include recommendations to Board/Senior Management for change/improvement which related to question b i) experience of research and analysis of complex information and compilation of formal, structured reports to include recommendations to Board/Senior Management for change/improvement (set in context the information analysed, reports written and the purpose and outcome of these to give an indication of the level at which you operated (max 500 words)) in the application form;
- track record of delivering work that has driven performance improvement which related to question b ii) track record of delivering work that has driven performance improvement (Provide detail of the impact of the work you delivered and how this was measured or evident within the subject organisation (max 500 words)) in the application form; and
- knowledge and understanding of the criminal justice system which related to question c in the application form.

Question 3

The expectation of the short listing panel was that detailed evidence and an operational understanding under each of the essential criteria would be demonstrated by each candidate in their application form.


