Thank you for your recent Freedom of Information request submitted via email to Criminal Justice Inspection Northern Ireland (CJI) on 05 March 2014 in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Our understanding of the information requested is as follows:

- the total number of laptops owned by your organisation that were registered to and/or in the possession of staff members (whether directly employed by your organisation or otherwise) on the following two dates:
  - 1) 1 May 2010 (or nearest available date – please specify), and
  - 2) 1 May 2013 (or nearest available date – please specify).

In answer to your request for information, I can confirm that the following information is being released in response to your enquiry.

**Query 1**

I can confirm that on 1 May 2010, 13 laptops were owned by the organisation, 11 of which were in the possession of staff members for work purposes.

**Query 2**

I can confirm that on 1 May 2013, 10 laptops owned by the organisation were in the possession of 10 staff members for work purposes.

I hope this response satisfies your request.
