Thank you for your Freedom of Information request submitted via email to Criminal Justice Inspection Northern Ireland on 19 August 2009 in accordance with Section 8 of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Our understanding of the information requested is as follows:

- If any members of senior management within this organisation have attended courses/participated in exercise to improve team building/leadership, communication and or management skills either on or off site as stated in your request;
- a list of companies/organisations who have provided these services on its behalf;
- a list of occasions when staff participated in such activities as well as the date, venue, location of the event, the number of staff participating and details of the duration of the event?
- the overall cost of each event including accommodation and or transport costs for off site events;

- a brief description of the event, what it involved and the reason why the event was felt to be worthwhile?
- if this organisation has used the services of Olivier Mythodrama and if so on how many occasions, the name of the package/sessions or courses used or paid for; and
- if these packages/courses were themed around Shakespeare's plays, which play/s were involved; the date of the session/s, which staff took part and the cost of the individual sessions.

In answer to your request, I can inform you that none of Criminal Justice Inspection Northern Ireland's senior management attended/participated in courses or exercises between 19 August 2008 and 19 August 2009 of the nature described by you in your enquiries of 19 August 2009.

I can also inform you this organisation has not at any time used the services of the company Olivier Mythodrama.

I hope this response satisfies your request.
