

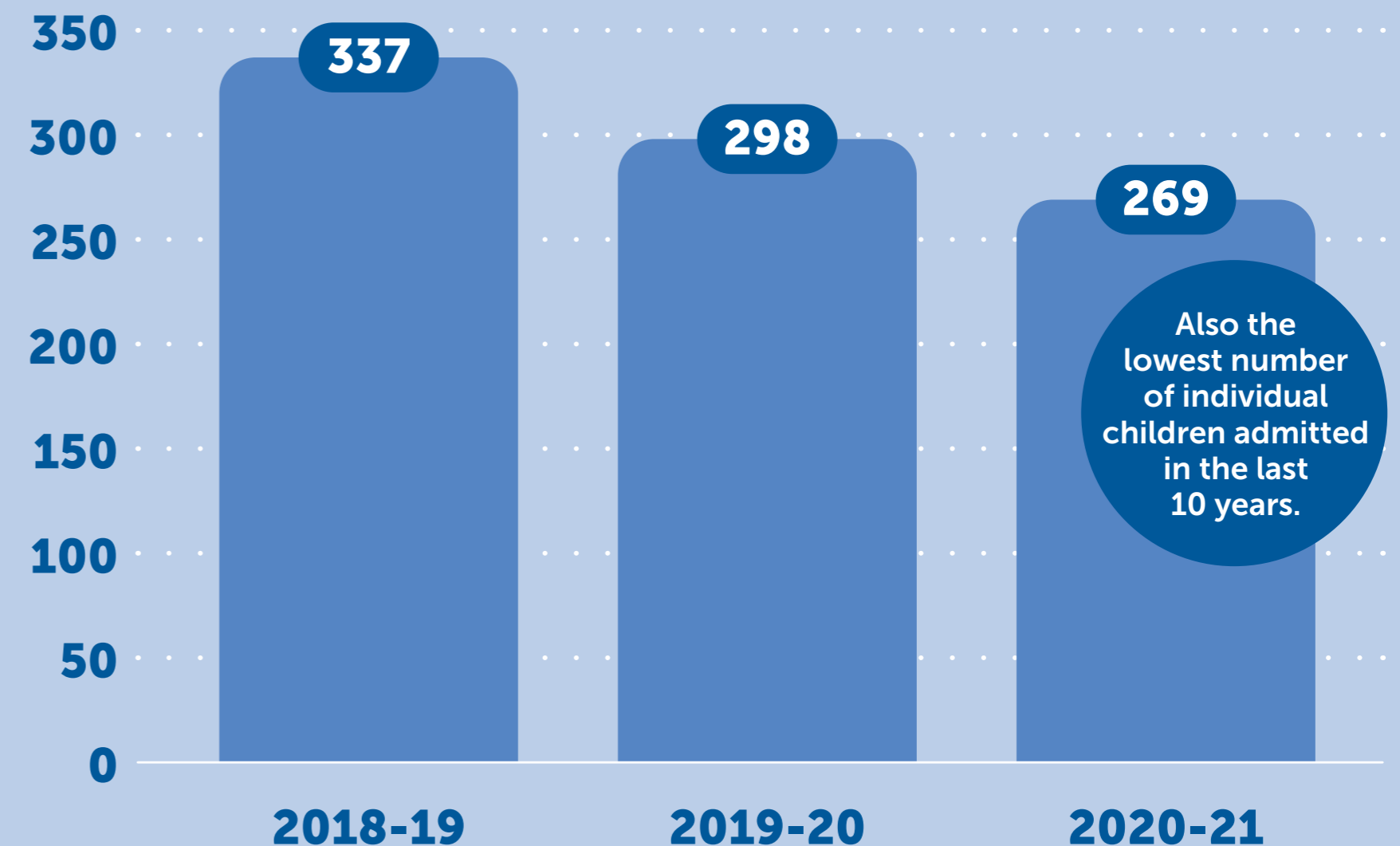

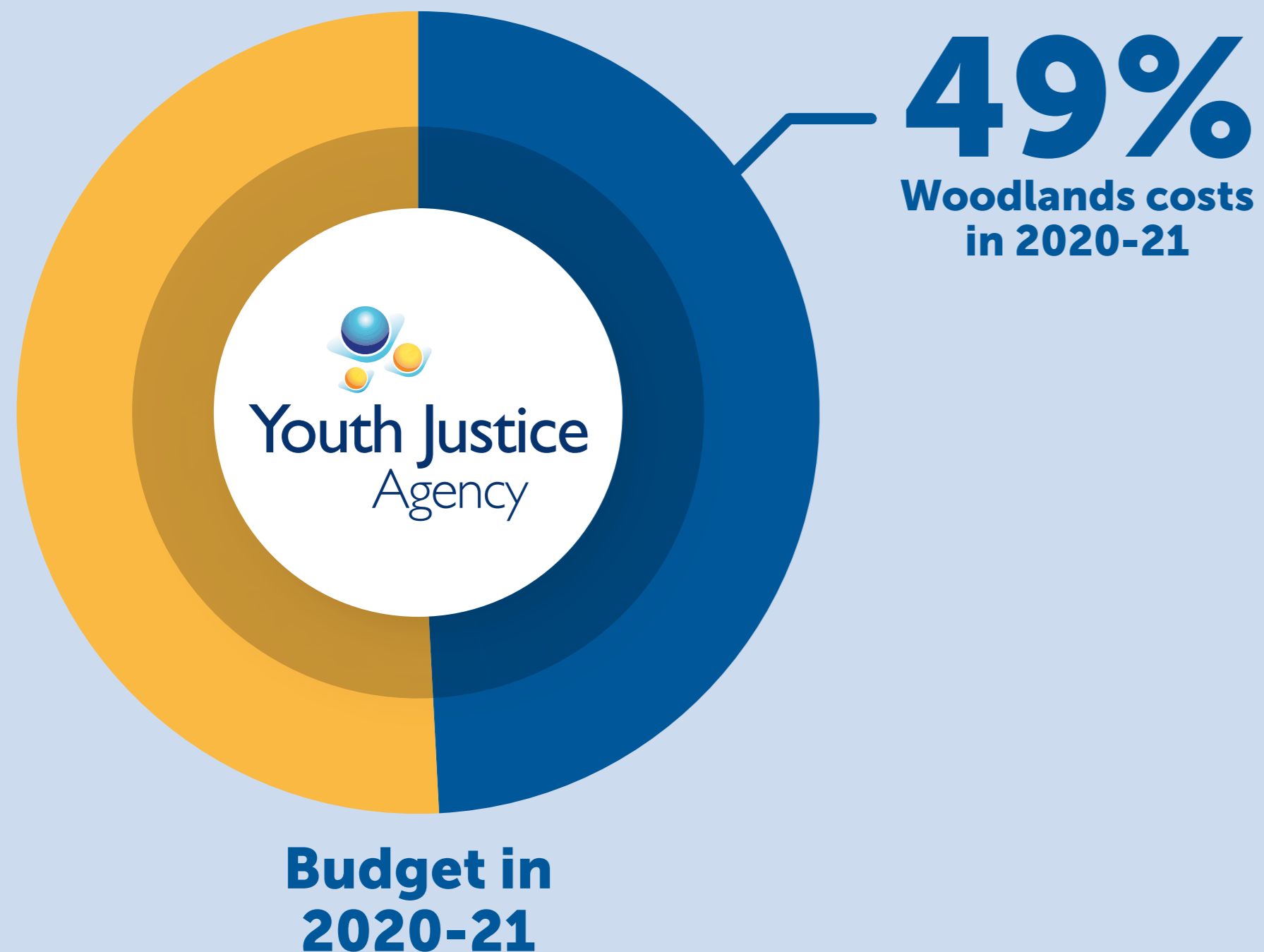
Woodlands can hold 48 children aged 10-17 years and is staffed to hold 36 children. When the Inspection fieldwork took place in January 2022 there were 10 children held at Woodlands.

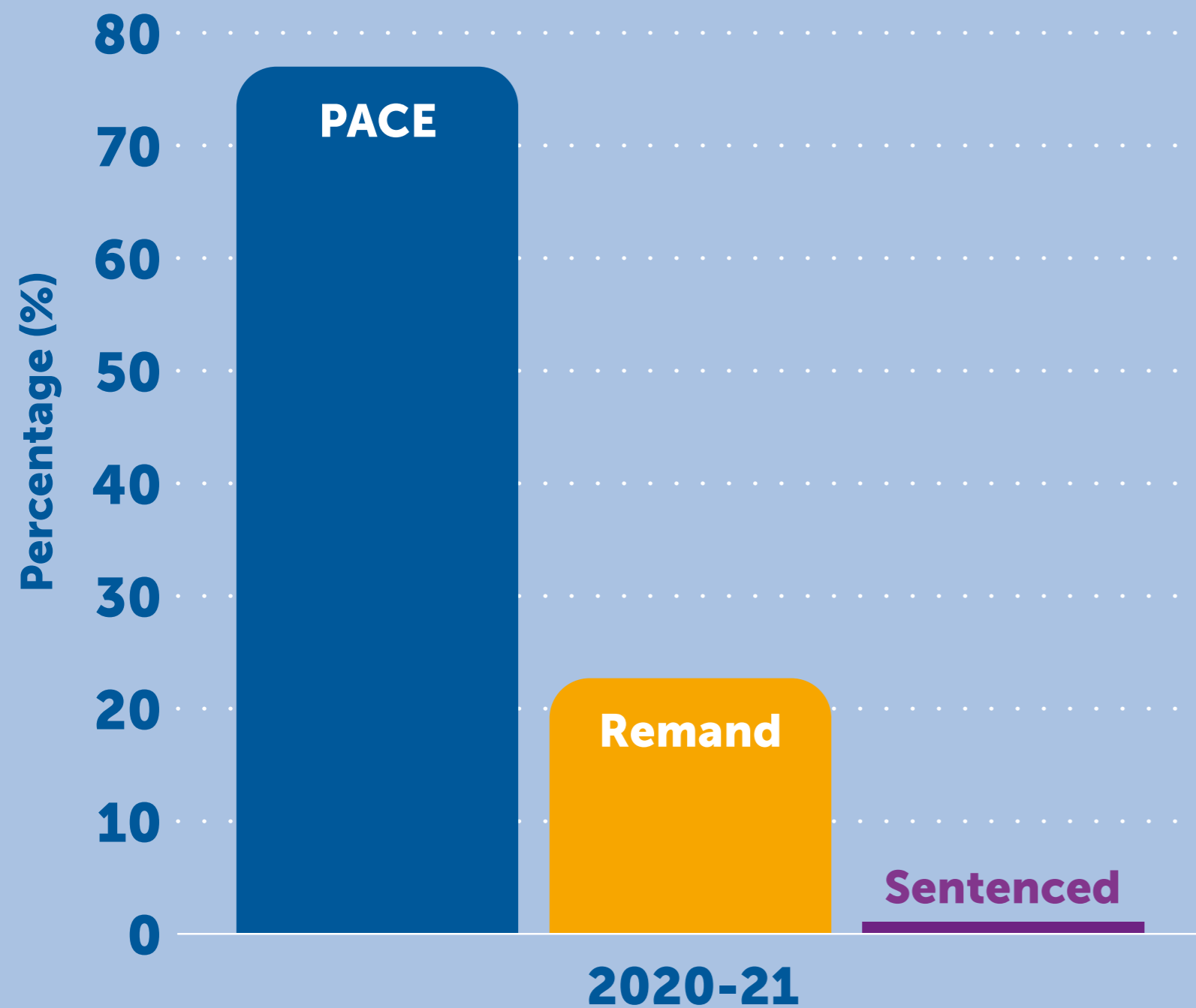

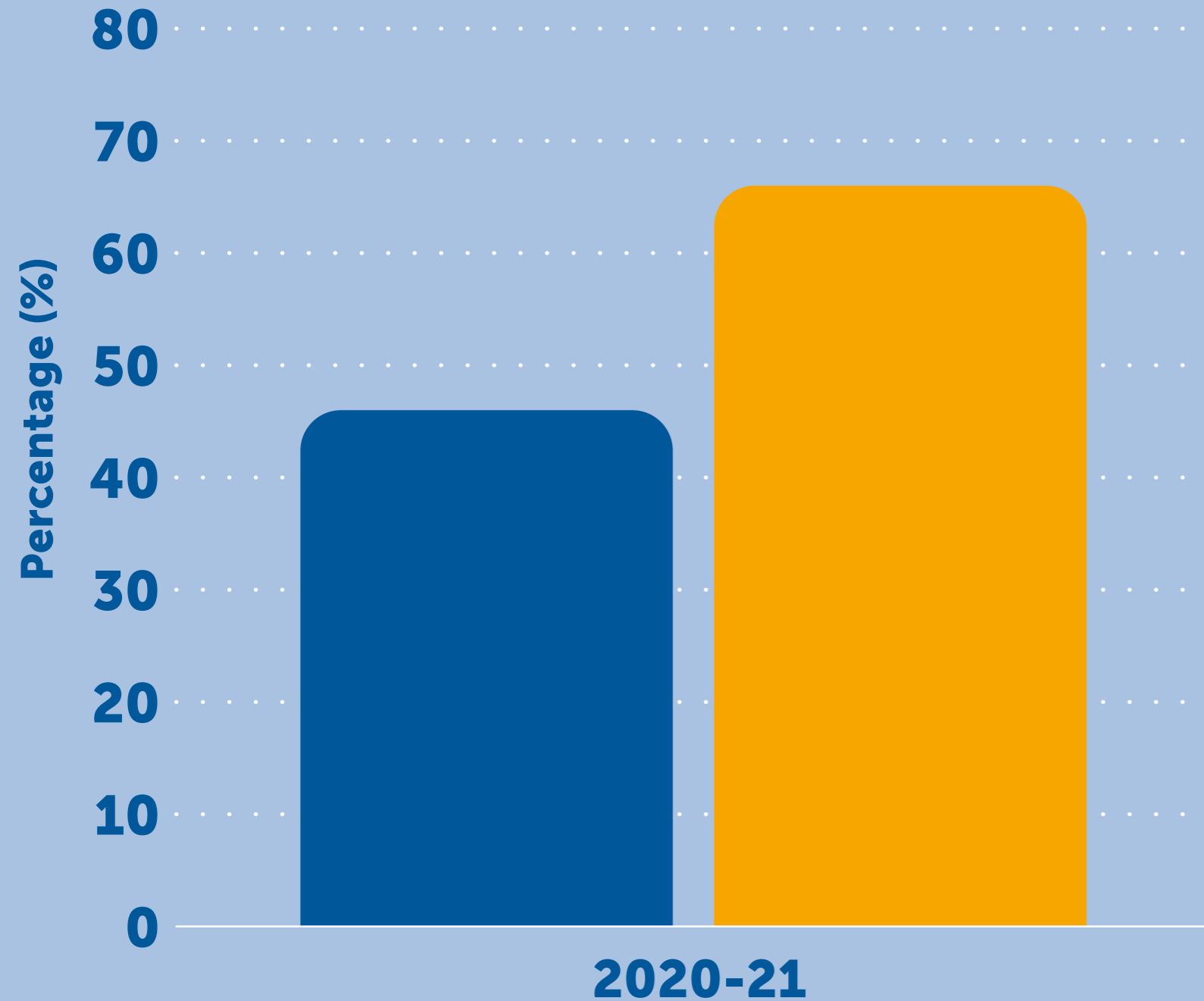

- 22.7%** were on remand
- 0.7%** were sentenced young people
The proportion of sentenced admissions decreased since the last inspection (3.8% in 2017-18).

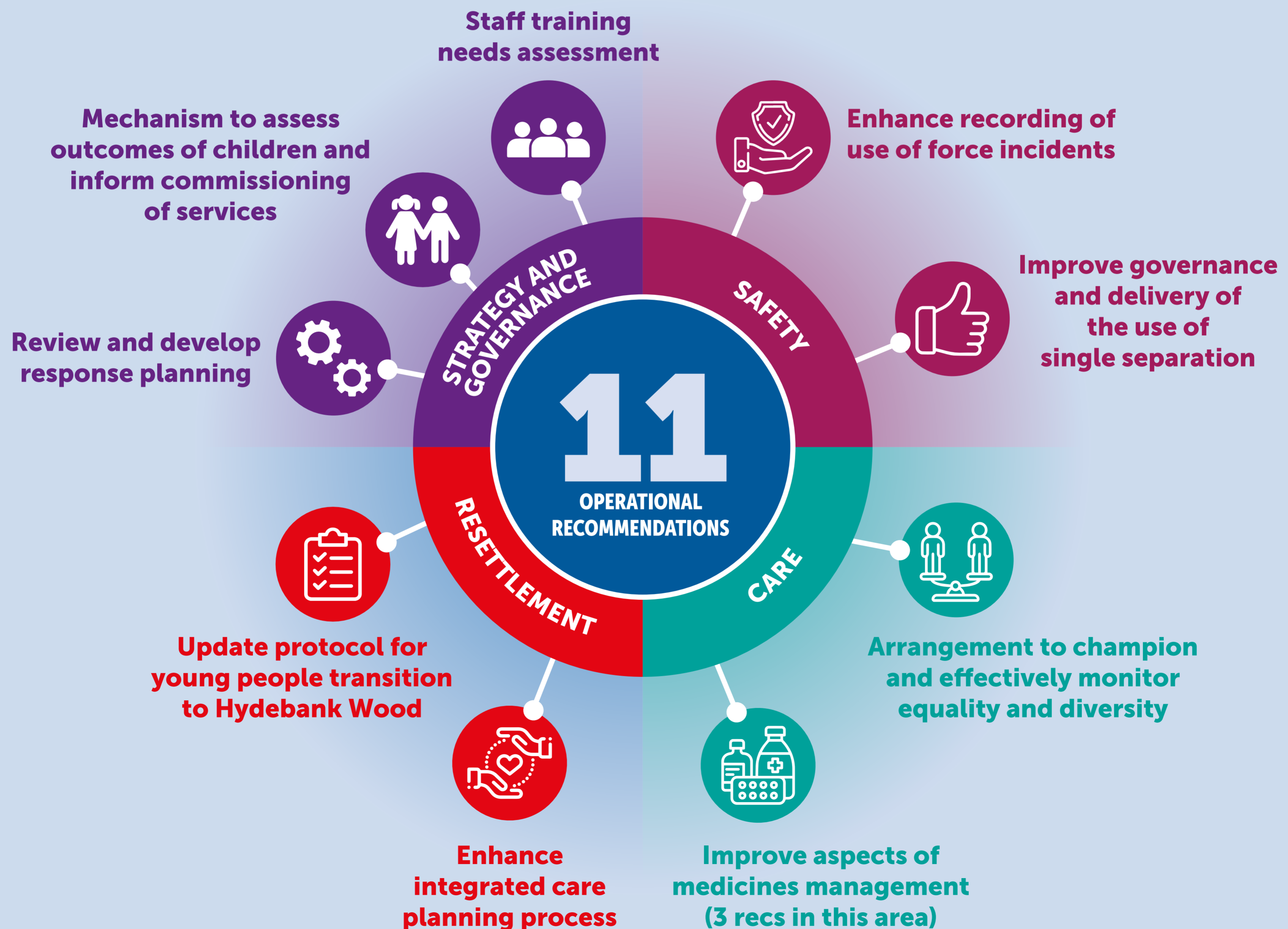
