## 1.0 Minutes

- 2.0 Matters arising and the status of actions from previous management reviews in dealing with risks and opportunities ISO Clause 9.3.2 (a)
  - There were no matters arising.
- 3.0 Finance and Audit and information on the performance of external providers. ISO Clause 9.3.2 (c)
  - JJ provided papers outlining the resource funding position as at June 2017 which were presented by MMcV. There were no major changes since the last report.
